Designer Manon Youdale has answered your call with chandeliers, coffee tables, sculptures and umbrella racks fashioned from antlers. On the subject of first seeing the intriguing horns of antlers during a skiing trip to Aspen 15 years ago, Youdale says,

"I was transfixed by the wild, masculine yet sensual shapes they produced." Although the skiier-cum-design-guru only started her business in April 2007, she has since "produced work for private homes, nightclubs, bars, polo clubs — and very modern houses and apartments." The reaction to her twisted creations? "It's been extremely

positive — and I've noticed a huge amount of curiousity. There is a real 'wow' factor with antlers, especially once you see them and hold them in your hands. Some people are concerned about the deer, until I explain that all male deer shed their antlers yearly. So what I am creating and working with is what nature has left behind for me to use.

No deer have been harmed in any way. There is a huge global movement to use antiers and the interest has now hit Australian shores." A nifty wordsmith too, Manon Youdale's company moniker draws on her surname—ILLUMANON—and her latest range is called ChanDeerLier.

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
